GUIDELINES FOR MINING LICENCE APPLICATION

- 1. Name of company applying for mining licence
- 2. Names and nationality of the directors or equivalent officers of the company
- 3. The name of any person holding more than 5% of the issues share capital (if company has share capital)
- 4. The mineral which you intend to mine
- 5. The map of the area over which the licence is sought on the 1:50,000 map series
- 6. Names of lawful occupiers of a holding in that area
- 7. The period in which the licence is sought
- 8. Technological report on mining and treatment responsibilities
- 9. Statement of the programme of mining operations you intend to carry out during the life of the licence
- 10. Estimated date you intend to carry out your mining operations for a profit
- 11. Estimated capacity of production and scale of operations
- 12. Estimated overall recovery of the ore and mineral product
- 13. The significant effect which the carrying out of mining operations will have on the environment
- 14. Proposals for the prevention of pollution, the treatment of waste and safeguarding of natural resources
- 15. Particulars of the expected infrastructure to be carried out in the area
- 16. Proposals with respect to employment and training of Malawian citizens
- 17. Proposals for the procurement of goods and services required for the project
- 18. Details of capital investment, operating costs and revenues and the anticipated type and source of financing
- 19. Application fee of K100,000.00

NOTE: Environmental Management Act requires that you prepare and submit to the Director of Environmental Affairs an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) for his perusal and approval before any mining operations commence.
